Install Picture Motion Browser (refer to the installation guide for PMB)

Connect the media (e.g. external USB-drive) that contains the backed up data and open it with Windows Explorer.

Copy each folder to a directory of choice on your PC. In this example the two folders ("My images" and "holiday") are copied to the PC.

Note:

If already a folder with the same name exists on the PC a warning message will be displayed. It is recommended to rename the backed up folder (e.g. "My Picures\_01") and then copy the folder to the PC.

Register the copied backup folder with PMB.

Choose [File] > [Add folders] and browse the directory to register the backup folders.

Choose [Tools] > [Settings] and click on "Advanced Settings" and verify the directory of the folder named "custom property settings". By default they are stored in the "Sony PMB" folder.

Close the screen by clicking on [Cancel] once you have verified the location of the folder.
